The Owner hereby grants to the Government the right to enter upon the lands hereinafter described at any time for a period of 6 months, in order to perform land surveying, environmental assessment, geotechnical assessment, and carry out such other exploratory work as may be necessary to complete the investigation being made of said lands by the Government.
- 2. This right-of-entry includes the right of ingress and egress on the lands of the Owner described herein, provided such ingress and egress is necessary and not otherwise conveniently available to the Government.

The land affected by this right-of-entry is located in the State of North Carolina, County of Wake, and is described above on page 1 of 2 and shown on the attached map.
