The Morrisville Town Council got an inside look at Wake County's new Morrisville Community Library building and programs recently. The Library will feature close to 50,000 books, have regularly scheduled programs, offer public computers, high-speed wireless and other services. Located at 310 Town Hall Drive.



## McCrimmon Parkway Project

### Your Bond Dollars at Work - Phase One Complete

This new stretch of roadway is the first step to making connections and improving traffic flow in this area. Phase One connects McCrimmon Parkway from NC54 through Perimeter Parkway to Airport Boulevard.

The four lane roadway has sidewalks/multi-use paths on each side, an improved railroad crossing at NC54 adding a left-turn lane, right-turn lane and other associated intersection improvements at Perimeter and NC54.

Phase Two continues to make progress and is an NCDOT administered construction project estimated to be completed in 2020. This will be a vital connection from McCrimmon Parkway at NC54 to Aviation Parkway at Evans Road.

- ☑ Keep important documents in a safe place or create password-protected digital copies
- ☑ Protect your property by clearing drains and gutters
